It has enormous charm due to its superb performance, but also thanks to its design of the gas tank that gives the bike its nickname of "disco volante" (flying saucer). The Super Sport was the dream of all sports bike enthusiasts and was often used for racing. The "Earles" type front fork is one of the main characteristics of this model.
