

125 "Zefiro" (1947)

The first motorcycle produced in Cascina Costa was a simple, light 98cc motorcycle, produced in 1946. Only a year later a far more interesting 125cc motorcycle was designed, with a refined 2 stroke twin cylinder engine. The specifications also included a 4 speed gearbox. The colour was an elegant metallic grey. A promosing project that never reached production.


