The 125 Turismo Rapido of 1954 was the first 4 stroke 125cc from Cascina Costa, and it evolved into the "Centomila" five years later. The name indicates the mileage attainable according to the manufacturer, a clear indication of the reliability reached by the new engine. The most important modification concerned the lubrication system that included a gear driven pump, a larger oil sump and a centrifugal oil filter system.
