The America was the final stage in the evolution of the 4 cylinder road-going MV's. The aesthetics were more aggressive (the seat had a tail cover, the exhausts were black) and the engine was more powerful (the displacement went up to 790cc). It was available with spoked wheels as well. As for the previous models in the series, it was heavy and had shaft drive, therefore hindering sports riding. However, the attraction towards this Italian sports bike was high and it remains one of the most significant motorcycles of the decade.
